

## **State Policy 2.103.1**

Students must complete three (3) credits in an elective focus. All students will pursue a focused program of study designed to prepare them for the workforce and postsecondary study. The intent of the elective focus is to provide students with an opportunity to explore a particular academic area in greater depth. The elective focus may be CTE, science and math, humanities, fine arts, AP/IB, or other areas approved by the local board of education. Students completing a CTE elective focus must complete three (3) credits in the same CTE career cluster or state-approved program of study.

### **ADDITIONAL ELECTIVE FOCUS PATHWAYS**

#### **Humanities**

Students must earn 3 credits in addition to the four English credits, three Social Studies credits, and two Foreign Language credits required for graduation.

#### **ROTC**

Students may choose ROTC as an elective focus area OR as substitution for core requirements.

**Advanced Academics** to include dual enrollment (DE), dual credit (DC), and Advanced Placement (AP)
