

# RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET OF MILLINGTON MUNICIPAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET AMENDMENT EIGHT

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 49-2-301(W)(i) provides that the budget shall set forth in itemized form the amount necessary to operate the schools for the scholastic year beginning on July 1, following, or on such date as provided for by charter or private legislative act; and (ii) that any change in the expenditure of money as provided for by the budget shall be ratified by the local board and the appropriate local legislative body; AND

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget and appropriate said funds as reflected as described below;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Millington Municipal School District hereby approves the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 amended budget and appropriates said funds, as described below, thereby amending the aggregate budgeted expenditures from \$25,333,757 to an aggregate budget of \$25,191,842. A summary of the budget impact can be found on Exhibit A hererin. Included below is a summary of the respective components of the budget amendment. A detailed list of the accounts being modified can be found on Exhibit B herein.

- 1. General Purpose School Fund The federal pre-k grant expired in 2019 and was replaced with Seeding Success. Seeding Success is now responsible for the two pre-k classrooms located at E.A. Harrold.
- **2. General Purpose School Fund** The District will fund all of the pre-k classes at Millington Elementary with the voluntary pre-k funding received from the state.
- 3. General Purpose School Fund An estimate for retirement contributions has been revised.
- **4. General Purpose School Fund** The District was reimbursed approximately \$9,800 for the costs associated with providing transportation to special needs students. The reimbursement revenue was not originally contemplated in the budget.
- **5. General Purpose School Fund** -The District received a \$5,000 donation from Battelle Education restricted for Millington Middle School. The District will receipt the transaction and provide the funds to Millington Middle School to be used on STEM related activities.
