### **STUDENT ACADEMIC GROWTH - ARE STUDENTS IMPROVING?**

The student academic growth indicator measures individual student growth using the value-added model known as the Tennessee Value-Added Assessment System (TVAAS). All schools and districts receive an overall student growth level equal to their TVAAS composite level, which ranges from Level 1 to Level 5 with Level 5 being the highest performing and Level 1 being the lowest performing.
