- Recommended approval to <u>contract with Hiland Dairy to provide milk, dairy</u> and <u>ice cream products</u> for school nutrition with a contract period of August 1, 2022 through July 31, 2023 for an estimated cost of \$110,000. Funding has been identified in the FY23 School Nutrition Budget.

Recommended approval for a <u>Partner Service Agreement with Instruction Partners to provide</u> <u>math implementation support for the 2022-23 and 2023-24 school year in the amount of \$136,503</u>. Funding has been identified through the Tennessee Department of Education funded Math Implementation Support Grant.
- 13. Recommended approval for the <u>renewal of the iReady program for the 2022-23 school year to include grades K-8 in the amount of \$58,752.50</u>. Funding has been identified in the FY23 General Fund with plans to amend the ESSER III budget to fund from there.

Recommended approval for the <u>renewal of Instructure Assessments</u> (formerly called Case 21 <u>Benchmark Assessments</u>) and <u>Mastery Connect for the 2022-23 school year for all three schools in the amount of \$42,771.00</u>. Funding has been identified in the FY23 General Fund with plans to amend the ESSER III budget to fund from there.
- 15. Recommended approval to <u>purchase 340 Lenovo Chromebooks along with Google Admin Licensing and Gumdrop cases from CDW under a Sourcewell contract for \$123,420</u>. Funding has been identified in the FY22 Technology budget but is fully subsidized by ECF/USAC funding.
- 16. Recommended approval to add 24/7 monitoring at a cost of \$8,400 to the GoGuardian Beacon quote that was presented and approved at the June 2022 BOE meeting. This quote is still under a Sourcewell contract. Funding has been identified in the FY23 General Fund Budget.
